4 Days - 3 Nights

The sample itinerary described below is approximately like the itinerary your group will be following during your stay. However, the exact times, days, and destinations may vary for your group.

- **Day 1** A morning departure has you traveling into gentile **Savannah**, **GA**. Upon arrival you will check into the **Hampton Inn Historic District** and have a chance to become acquainted with your surroundings. Tonight you will enjoy a **buffet dinner at the famous Pirates House Restaurant**.
- Day 2 After breakfast, head for the Savannah Visitors Center where you will meet your guide for a 2-hour tour of one of the largest restored National Historic Landmark Districts in the nation. You will see restored 18th and 19th century buildings and the waterfront where cotton warehouses are now restaurants, hotels, and shops. This beautiful city eloquently displays exquisite ironwork, ancient cobblestones, splendid mansions and picturesque cottages. There will be time for lunch on your own at Savannah's River Walk with time to browse the unique shops along the way. In the afternoon, visit Savannah History Museum, housed in the old Central of Georgia Railway passenger shed and dating to the 1850s. The museum is now home to more than 10,000 artifacts including Forest Gump's bench, one of Johnny Mercer's Oscar Awards, and a carriage owned by the family of Girl Scouts founder, Juliette Gordon Lowe. You may also enjoy a film presentation of "Savannah the Survivor" in the theatre. This evening you will enjoy a family-style dinner at Food Network personality, Paula Deen's The Lady & Sons Restaurant.
- Day 3 Following breakfast, check out and depart for historic Charleston, SC. Arrive for lunch at the Charleston Crab House. In the afternoon, meet your guide for a 2-hour Historic Charleston Tour. Charleston is one of the most beautiful and historic cities in the South. During your tour you will see White Point Garden, Rainbow Row, Old Exchange Building, Four Corners of Law, Site of Gadsden Wharf, the U.S. Custom House, Ashley Hall, The Battery, College of Charleston and several historic churches. After the tour, check into the Hampton Inn Charleston Historic District and prepare for a fantastic Charleston Harbor Dinner Cruise with Spiritline Cruises.
- Day 4 Enjoy breakfast, then check out and depart for home with fond memories of **Charleston & Savannah**.
